Most common oral and maxillofacial trauma accounts for zygomaticomaxillary complex. The consequences include flattening of the face resulting in increased facial width1,2,3,4,5. Our case report mentions the importance of conservative management of left ayngomaticomaxillary complex fracture comprising of maxilla, zygoma and zygomatic arch.
