In this study we got the background (age, sex, education, marital status, type of family and their income mode) information of 106 respondent in which 53 were females and 53 were males, they all were doing the job of harvesting of rose and marigold as well as commercial value of both flowers and also a table showed that number of flower harvesters accordingly females and males both. In study rose and marigold flowers are defined with their commercial value in word, their propagation area is also described here. Labor who work for rose are 76% and 24% for marigold in 63.64% were women and 36.36% were men.
